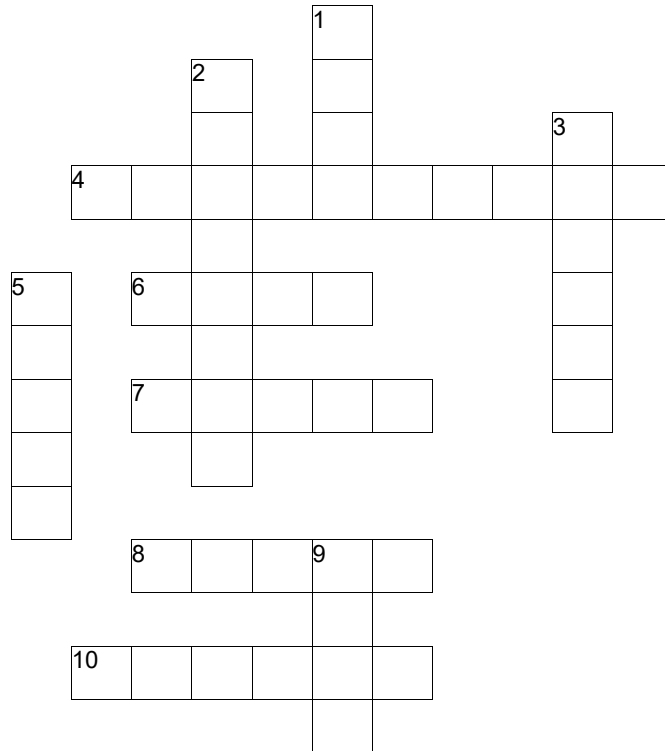


# We Like Ike Crossword Puzzle
