COURSES OF ACTION IN RESPECT TO OVERSEAS CHINESE IN SINGAPORE
AND FEDERATION OF MALAYA, PREPARED BY OCB WORKING
GROUPS ON NSC 5503 AND NSC 5405

A. POLITICAL

1. Attempt to secure from the UK such political action as possible to help to counter or reduce the slow deterioration of the international position of the Government of the Republic of China with the particular objective of reducing the effectiveness of Chinese Communist agents in Malaya and Singapore.

Action: State

2. Use every means to impress on responsible UK officials the gravity and urgency of Communist subversion in Malaya.

Action: State

3. Seek maximum UK cooperation in the fundamental political action required, that of the firm exercise of control by their authorities.

4. Consult with the Australian Government on the desirability and feasibility of using Australian Government

5. As a longer term proposal consider the desirability of sociological and other investigations among the Overseas Chinese in Malaya as a guide to future approaches to the problem.

B. SCHOOLS

1. Develop means of introducing anti-Communist teachers (possibly from Hong Kong, Taiwan or the U.S.) and lecture material into Chinese schools.

Action: State and others as appropriate.

2. Urge the British as appropriate to establish a polytechnic school in Singapore which would be of college level and offer instruction in Chinese at least in part.

Action: State-ICA

3. Urge a more forcible use of police power in breaking up Communist cells in Chinese schools.

Action: State and others as appropriate.

4. Persuade the British authorities to screen locally-produced Chinese language material as well as that imported from Communist China.

Action: State

5. Seek agreement with the British on recognition of American university degrees.

Action: State

6. In addition to the introduction of anti-Communist teachers and lecture materials referred to above, seek to bring in more athletic coaches and teams from other free world territories.

Action: State and others as appropriate.

C. PUBLICATIONS

1. Consider on an urgent basis the feasibility of bringing into being a pro world newspaper in Singapore.

2. Urge the British to bring pressure to bear on advertisers in Communist-controlled or oriented publications.
