1. AFGHANISTAN. Soviet efforts at economic penetration of Afghanistan appear to be achieving considerable success, G-2 comments. The recent heavy influx of Soviet technicians into Afghanistan is not justified by the magnitude of known Soviet-Afghan aid projects.
