Harry Darby signed an instrument of gift for the papers on October 14, 1967. Portions of the Darby's personal papers formerly housed in the Darby Corporation Papers at the Kansas State Historical Society were transferred to the Eisenhower Library under an instrument of gift signed by the corporation on January 23, 1990.

Literary rights in the unpublished writings of Harry Darby in this collection and in all other collections of papers received by the United States government have been donated to the public. Under terms of the instrument of gift, the following classes of items are withheld from research use:

1. Papers which constitute an invasion of personal privacy or a libel of a living person.
2. Papers which are required to be kept secret in the interest of national defense or foreign policy, and are properly classified.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

This series contains materials relating to Harry Darby's personal, professional, and political life and document the business activities of the Darby Corporation, his farms, civic and fraternal organizations, philanthropic activities, Republican part, and defense contracts. Materials within the series include correspondence, financial records, corporate memoranda, telegrams, newsletters, livestock and horse breed registrations, catalogs, political advertising, real estate information, applications from job seekers, and other related material. See the description for each annual subseries for subject information.

Preliminary processing took place in 2006. An initial arrangement was created, preservation copies were made of unstable paper items, and the documents were placed in acid-free folders and boxes. Detailed review and processing began in 2017.

Boxes are arranged into annual subseries. The summary below lists the major subjects found in each annual subseries. Some folders contain only documents relating to a specific subject, organization, or event. Other folders contain documents received from a wide range of persons or organizations with a name beginning with that specific letter of the alphabet and will contain a wide range of subjects. These alphabetical folders contain a wide range of topics.

The folders are arranged alphabetically within each subseries. Inside the folders documents are arranged in reverse chronological order or, occasionally, alphabetically by name. Some folders contain documents created prior to the date of the annual subseries and that date range is indicated in brackets. For example, in the 1938 Correspondence, the folder Memorial Building, Kansas City, Kansas [1925-38] contains documents dating from 1925 through 1938.
