#### SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The papers of Mary Jane McCaffree span the years 1952 to 1994. The majority of these materials document her work as social secretary to Mamie Eisenhower and provide insight into social activities at the White House from 1953 to 1961. The papers are divided into three series: White House Social Office, Post-Presidential, Miscellaneous, and Mary Jane McCaffree's Scrapbooks.

Photographs from all series were removed from the files and transferred to the audiovisual collection of the Eisenhower Library. The two memorial tribute volumes were removed and transferred to the book collection of the Library.

#### **DESCRIPTION OF SERIES**

## WHITE HOUSE SOCIAL OFFICE SERIES

Boxes 1-4

This series contains records of White House social functions from 1953-61. The bulk of the materials were originally arranged chronologically in scrapbooks. There is a small amount of correspondence and memoranda relating to the functions of the White House Social Office. The correspondence and memoranda are arranged alphabetically.

Items originally housed in scrapbooks have been removed and placed in acid free folders for preservation purposes. Included in this series are guest lists, seating arrangements, menus, programs, and notes on each social function, including receptions, teas and dinners. Following the scrapbook material are correspondence and memoranda containing information relating to the functions of the Social Office, the use of Blair House, a variety of photographs, a list of Eisenhower's favorite songs, and other related documents. Also included are basic rules and protocol governing White House Social activities.

#### POST-PRESIDENTIAL SERIES

Box 4

This series contains hand-edited drafts by Dwight D. Eisenhower written during the post-Presidential years. Included are numerous drafts of Eisenhower's "Now That I Am A Private Citizen" article, dictated in California during February and March 1961, and drafts of campaign information for his memoirs dictated during a European trip during the summer of 1962. These are arranged chronologically.

## **MISCELLANEOUS SERIES**

Box 4

This series contains a small quantity of campaign material memorabilia, memorial tributes to Dwight D. Eisenhower and to John F. Kennedy, and miscellaneous writings by Eisenhower. Materials are arranged alphabetically.

#### MARY JANE McCAFFREE'S SCRAPBOOKS SERIES

Boxes 6-8

This series contains McCaffree's personal scrapbooks of memorabilia, newspaper clippings, articles, picture postcards, memoranda, schedules, press releases, menus (especially train, plane, and cruise menus), photographs, and other related items. These items relate to McCaffree's experiences traveling with the Eisenhowers, working at the White House, and special events she attended during that time. Although some events are mentioned in folder annotations, please consult Mamie Eisenhower's schedule in the White House Social Office files for a more complete information on the First Lady's activities. Items are arranged chronologically.

When received the materials were arranged in five deteriorating scrapbooks in roughly chronological order. Many individual items had become detached and more materials were inserted between the pages. Scrapbooks were disbound and items housed in folders. There were also traces of items that might have been included at some time but were no longer contained in the scrapbooks when they were received at the Eisenhower Library in 2005. Loose items included with the series are listed at the end of the series.
