SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The Eisenhower-Doud Collection of Clippings and Other Memorabilia consists of material that was collected by the Colorado State Historical Society of Denver. Because Mamie Eisenhower had grown up in Colorado, the Society began acquiring material on the Doud and Eisenhower families after Dwight D. Eisenhower became famous in World War II. Mamie's mother Mrs. Elivera Doud donated several family artifacts, including early clippings on the Eisenhowers from Denver newspapers and copies of the West Point news magazine which John S.D. Eisenhower had acquired while a cadet. Some of the items bear notations by Mamie Eisenhower.

The Society transferred the collection to the Eisenhower Library after the death of Dwight D. Eisenhower. When it was received the collection was in a disorganized state. The present arrangement was devised by a staff archivist. The material is arranged in three categories: memorabilia, magazines, and news clippings, and thereunder by subject or title. One box of oversized items is filed at the end of the collection.
