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SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

Following General Dwight D. Eisenhower's death on March 28, 1969, members of the general public, religious and secular organizations, and foreign and domestic governments (along with their representatives) sought to commemorate his life through a variety of memorial tributes presented to Mamie Doud Eisenhower. The tributes in this series date to 1969 and are arranged in four subseries according to the type of originator; "Individuals," "Organizations," "States and Counties" and "White House."

DESCRIPTION OF SERIES

Box Nos. Series

TRIBUTES ON DEATH OF GENERAL DWIGHT D. EISENHOWER, 1969

Subseries I: Individuals

1 – 5 The majority of tributes made by individuals are posthumous enrollments in various religious societies on General Eisenhower's behalf. These enrollments include commemorative certificates embellished with religious iconography and are typically bound in book form. Along with the enrollment certificates there are a few speeches, newspaper articles, and in one instance a record of a donation to a charitable cause made in Eisenhower's name. Names of notable individuals offering tributes include Omar Bradley and Lyndon Johnson. This series is arranged alphabetically by surname.

Subseries II: Organizations

5 – 10 Organizations, as defined within this series, are private, public, and non-governmental political bodies. Posthumous enrollments in various religious denominations, resolutions, dedications in magazines, signature books, records of memorial exercises, certificates, and from the United States Military Academy at West Point, a commencement address are included with the tributes. This subseries is arranged alphabetically by organizational name.

Subseries III: States and Counties

10 – 12 Tributes in this subseries are almost exclusively resolutions of condolence. This subseries is arranged alphabetically by state, thereunder by level of government from largest to smallest (state government, county government, city government), and thereunder alphabetically again. Foreign countries, United States territories, and military organizations are arranged alphabetically at the end of the States and Counties Subseries.

Subseries IV: White House

12 – 13 This subseries is a collection of condolence letters sent to the Nixon White House by foreign dignitaries and then collected and presented to Mamie Eisenhower. The White House subseries is arranged alphabetically by the sender's country.
