SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The papers of Harry W. Frantz span the years 1954 to 1961, when Mr. Frantz was an international editor and correspondent in the Washington Bureau of United Press International.

The papers consist of 26 notebook binders containing teletype print-outs of news stories written by Mr. Frantz, typed drafts of Frantz's stories, and a small amount of correspondence (some personal; some containing background material). Major subjects reflected in the stories: Latin American developments (economic, political, visits of U.S. officials, including President Eisenhower and Vice President Nixon, and conferences); Antarctica; U.S. politics (primarily presidential campaigns); Spain; and Portugal. Many of Frantz's articles were written for major South American newspapers. Many of the clippings, therefore, are in Spanish.
