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GRUENTHER, HOMER H.: Records, 1953-60

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SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

On January 21, 1953, Homer H. Gruenther was appointed as an Assistant to the Deputy Assistant to the President, serving as a member of the legislative liaison office. He served in the White House legislative liaison office until January 21, 1961.

The file consist of correspondence, telegrams, news clippings, press releases, memoranda, printed materials, photographs, charts and maps. The file has three segments, but no arrangement was discernible within the three segments. The first segment consists of materials showing the liaison office's work in establishing better relations between the White House and Congress through invitations to social functions and lunches with staff members, correspondence with winners and losers of elections and the arranging of special White House tours for congressmen's more important constituents. The second segment consists of the legislative liaison office's task of notifying congressmen of federal drought and disaster aid being sent to/or refused the areas they represent. The third segment consists of materials showing Gruenther's liaison work with Congress on the Upper Colorado and St. Lawrence Seaway legislation.

The listing of folders which follows represents a merging of Gruenther's files which were kept in his office and earlier portions of that file which were sent to the White House Central Files for storage as they were no longer needed for current office operations.
