SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

Wayne J. Hood, a manufacturer of La Crosse, Wisconsin, was active in Republican politics for many years. He served as Wisconsin state chairman of the Republican Party from 1950-1953, and was executive director of the Republican National Committee during 1952 and 1953. He was active in Barry Goldwater's 1964 campaign and Richard Nixon's 1968 campaign.

Mr. Hood donated his personal papers to the State Historical Society of Wisconsin. While processing the collection the staff found a quantity of Republican political literature and reports which Mr. Hood had collected. The historical society offered the material to the Eisenhower Library since the Library had extensive material on the Republican National Committee. The historical society also included in the donation a copy of the inventory of the Wayne Hood papers at the historical society.

This collection contains the material received from the State Historical Society of Wisconsin. The political material is arranged in chronological order. It consists primarily of speech material, statistical analyses of voting, and lists of political campaign workers. Most of this material was mass-produced by the Republican National Committee. One unusual item is a carbon copy of a report on the activities of the Speakers Bureau of the Republican Congressional Committee during the 1952 campaign. This report contains a detailed account of speeches given by members of Congress on behalf of Republican candidates during the campaign.
