SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The material in this file pertains primarily to Meyer Kestnbaum's duties as Special Assistant to the President for implementation of recommendations of the Commission on Organization of the Executive Branch of Government (called the "Second Hoover Commission"). The file also contains material pertaining to Mr. Kestnbaum's chairmanship of the Commission on Intergovernmental Relations and his role in implementing the recommendations of that Commission; and material on the Joint Federal-State Action Committee. The file is additionally important because it often reveals why some of the recommendations of the "Second Hoover Commission" were not implemented.

This file is not the working file of the Commission on Organization of the Executive Branch of Government ("Second Hoover Commission"), or any of the other commissions. It is Mr. Kestnbaum's own White House office file.
