Mrs. Sutton signed an instrument of gift for the papers on October 27, 1996. Literary rights in the unpublished writings of Mrs. Sutton in this collection and in all other collections of papers received by the National Archives have been donated to the public. Under terms of the instrument of gift, the following classes of items are withheld from research use:

- 1. Papers which constitute an invasion of personal privacy or a libel of a living person.
- 2. Papers which are required to be kept secret in the interest of national defense or foreign policy and are properly classified.

## SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

Mrs. Ione Ulrich Sutton was a financial officer at the Museum of Modern Art in New York City during the 1940s and 1950s. In 1951, while traveling in Europe with her husband George Sutton Jr., she met Dwight D. Eisenhower at NATO headquarters. Mr. Sutton had served under Eisenhower at Camp Colt, Pennsylvania, in 1918. When Eisenhower returned to the United States in 1952 to run for president, Mrs. Sutton worked as a volunteer at the headquarters of the Citizens for Eisenhower in New York City. The Suttons attended Eisenhower's inauguration as President in January 1953. Mrs. Sutton later worked as a volunteer for Citizens for Eisenhower during the 1956 campaign and as a volunteer at the finance committee of the Nixon-Lodge campaign in 1960.

The papers of Ione Ulrich Sutton consist primarily of social correspondence, campaign literature, printed material and memorabilia regarding her support for Dwight D. Eisenhower. The material is arranged in chronological order. Of particular importance are a financial report of the Citizens for Eisenhower organization during 1955-1956, and a report on the operation of the finance committee of the Nixon-Lodge campaign organization in 1960.
