#### SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The U.S. Army Photographic Agency was a branch of the Army Signal Corps. It was responsible for photographing official events involving U.S. Army personnel. During the state funeral for Dwight D. Eisenhower in 1969 agency personnel closely followed the events of the funeral and produced photographs and motion picture footage for the U.S. government and the public.

This collection consists primarily of photographs and press releases relating to the funeral of Dwight D. Eisenhower in 1969. A few clippings and several historic photographs covering earlier periods of Eisenhower's career are also included. These appear to have been collected by the Photographic Agency for reference purposes around the time of Eisenhower's death. Of particular importance is a copy of the Army plan for providing photographic coverage of the funeral. The Plan gives details of the work of Photographic Agency personnel during the funeral.
