INAUGURAL PARADE



1. There will be 75 seats in the President's reviewing stand for the parade, available for the Eisenhower family.
2. There will be 600 seats in the side wings for the personal distribution of General Eisenhower and Mrs. Eisenhower.
3. Also, 150 seats in the parade stand, across from the White House, will be reserved for the disposition of General Eisenhower and Mrs. Eisenhower.

Public Sale of Parade Tickets

A special parade stand ticket office is set up at 812 Connecticut Avenue, N. W. - Washington, D. C. Prices range from \$3.00 to \$15.00, depending on location.

The charts of the stands and the tickets themselves will not be available until December 21st, so only applications are now being accepted.

Current plans call for 39 stands, seating 60,000. There will be one free stand, to seat 1000 disabled veterans, as guests of the Inaugural Committee.
