FURTHERMORE, THE EPIDEMIC ONSET IS MONTHS EARLIER IN THE SOUTHERN REGIONS OF THE U.S. E.G. IN HARRIS COUNTY 25 CASES HAVE ALREADY BEEN REPORTED. THESE CONSIDERATIONS OF CONCENTRATION OF DISEASE AND TIME ON ONSET SHOULD WEIGH DISTRIBUTION OF COMMERCIAL VACCINE JUST AS ITS ADMINISTRATION HAS BEEN RECOMMENDED FOR AGES FOR PEAK INCIDENCE
